ELEMENTARY SCHOOL TEXTBOOKS

With the enforcement of Right to Education Act (RTE) 2009, the SCERT was declared the Academic Authority for Elementary Education in Mizoram for the purpose of Section 29 of the Right of Children to Free & Compulsory Education Act 2009 on the 22nd September, 2010. Sub-Rule 2 of Section 23 of the Mizoram Right of Children to Free & Compulsory Education Act 2011 states that – 2) while laying down the curriculum and evaluation procedure, the academic authority notified under the Sub-Rule (i) shall -

1. Formulate the relevant age-appropriate syllabus and textbooks and other learning materials.
2. Develop in-service teacher training design, and
3. Prepare guidelines for putting into practice Continuous and Comprehensive Assessment for learning.

Following the above mentioned guidelines, the SCERT established a Textbook Cell manned by 5(five) Officers and initiated formulation of age-appropriate curricula and syllabi in keeping with the NCF 2005 and textbook reform in 2012. The then existing elementary textbooks prescribed and published by the Mizoram Board of School Education (MBSE) were reviewed and revised in keeping with the NCF 2005 for use in the academic session 2013 – 2014.

The SCERT then introduced the NCERT textbooks developed as per the National Curriculum Framework(NCF) 2005 with an aim at providing quality textbooks at a cheaper price to students. They were introduced in Classes I to IV from the academic session 2015-2016 and extended to Class V in 2016-2017 and to Class VI, VII, VIII in 2017-2018.

These textbooks are adapted to suit local needs, they are also translated for use in Mizo Medium Schools. The English version is used in English Medium Schools and the translated Mizo version is used in Mizo Medium Schools. This policy of using adapted/ translated NCERT textbooks is envisaged to help our students in the long run when they prepare for National level examinations in future course of time.

The SCERT further developed its own textbooks on Mizo and Hindi subjects in the line with NCERT textbooks in terms of quality and price. These textbooks on Mizo and Hindi subjects are introduced alongwith the NCERT textbooks in Elementary Schools since 2015.

Procedure for printing of textbooks:

Sealed Tenders are invited from bonafide reputed offset printers for printing of NCERT textbooks for a period of at least 21 days. For wide circulation, the Tender Notice is published in 3(three) local newspapers and the SCERT website www.scert.mizoram.gov.in as well as tender site of Govt. of Mizoram www.tender.mizoram.gov.in.

The sealed tenders are received and opened after 21 days in the presence of department officials and bidders and a Checklist of the Bids is prepared for scrutiny of tenders.

A meeting of Technical Committee is held to evaluate tenders received and to prepare Comparative Statement and Technical Report. Then the Report of the Technical Committee along with the Comparative Statement are laid before the State Purchase Advisory Board (SPAB) chaired by the Chief Secretary, Government of Mizoram for selection of Printer to print the textbooks

In this way, the SPAB selected Bhabani Offset & Imaging System Pvt Ltd. Guwahati, Assam to print the elementary school textbooks for academic session of 2021-2022 and a number of 6,76,480 copies of textbooks are printed for the the current year.
